The formulaic drama, based on the popular novel by #1 NY Times Bestselling author Karen Kingsbury, tells the story of an architect who loses his best friend and then launches a search to find that woman's twin sister who who had been separated at birth. We both thought it was an overlong Hallmark movie. And we noticed that there didn't seem to be one actor over 35 or who wasn't beautiful. Rated G, though I wouldn't recommend bringing young children there.

B. We thought WISH MAN, which we saw on Amazon, was a far better film. It is a biopic about Frank Shankwitz, an Arizona motorcycle cop with a troubled past, who survives a near-fatal accident during a high-speed pursuit. He eventually meets a terminally ill young boy, and that inspires him to star the Make A Wish Foundation. The film started slowly, but by the end, it touched us. D. SCOOP: Now on Netflix


