A. Saw THREE IDENTICAL STRANGERS, an enthralling documentary about three young adults who are born identical triplets but then get adopted to different families. When they are reunited, the feel-good story becomes a viral hit in the pre-internet age. ... The reunion soon sets off a chain of events that uncovers a secret that transforms their story into a thriller that truly proves that truth is stranger than fiction. Rated PG-13.

B. Heard THE WORST-CASE SURVIVAL HANDBOOK (Listen & Live Audio), written by Joshua Piven and David Bergeron and narrated by Burt Reynolds. ... This book has useful, step-by-step instructions for you to follow if you ever needed to take over a plane if the pilot blacked out or deliver a baby in the back of a cab. ...
