

A. Saw CHRISTOPHER ROBIN, Disney's live action adventure about the young boy who loved embarking on trips with a band of spirited and lovable stuffed animals. He

has since grown up, gotten married and settled down, but in doing so, lost his way. ... Ewan McGregor is fine in the leading role, and there are some very sweet scenes. But overall, I was a bit bored by the film. Methinks that children would like it more than I did. .. Rated PG.

Note: The OTHER problem I had was that I had recently seen and loved GOODBYE CHRISTOPHER ROBIN, A 2017 British biographical drama about the lives of WINNIE-THE-POOH creator A.A. Milne and his family. It is far, far better than the Disney movie.

B. Enjoyed THE KILDEER CONNECTION (Kindle Press) by Tom Swyers, an attorney and former New York State judge. His novel involves a burned-out lawyer who attempts to find his friend's killer. There are many twists and turns that kept me intrigued until the last page. ... What helped was the fact that I genuinely liked the main character, as well as his family. I also liked one part involving a deposition. It felt very realistic. So did another part involving time spent in jail. ... The ending left me looking forward to what's slated to be a second and third book in the Lawyer David Thomas Series.

Note: Swyers' debut novel, SAVING BABE RUTH, was actually a prequel to the above book. I really liked that one, too, and encourage you to read it. .




