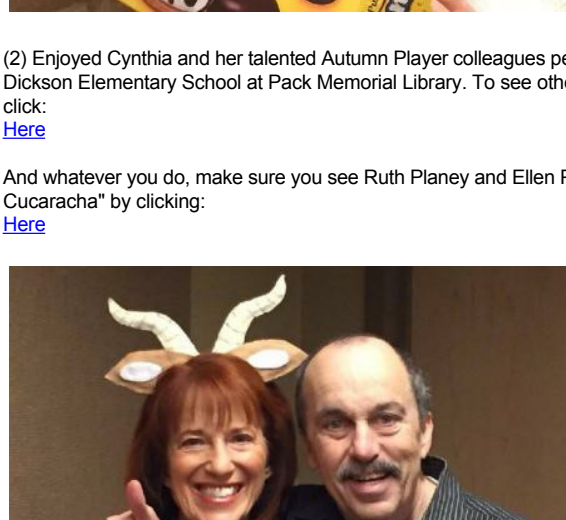

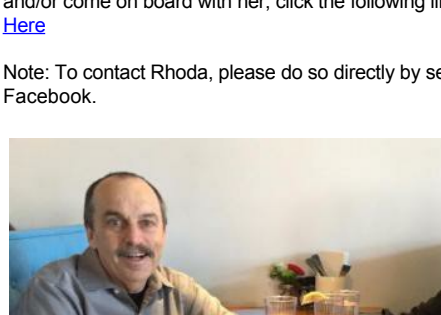

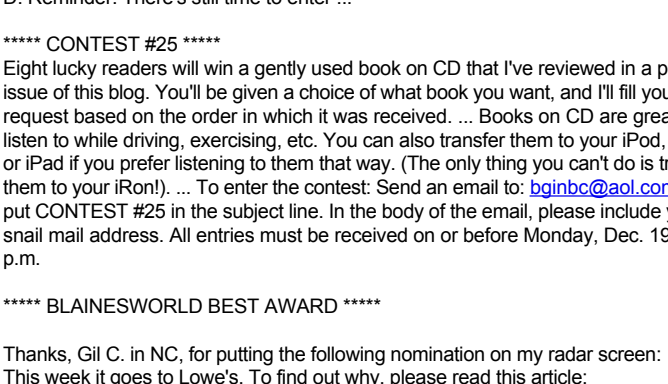
(6) Had a great Italian dinner at Favilla's New York Pizza. The food is always good there and so is the service. (That night, Grace was our server.)

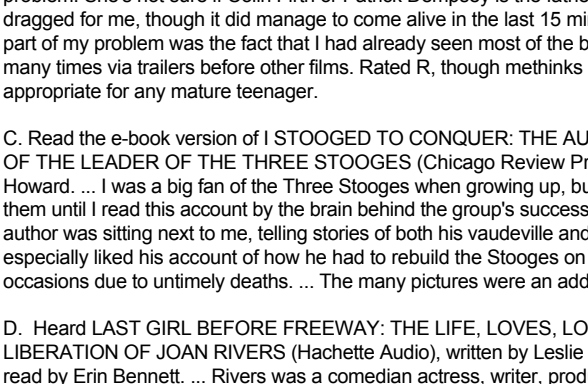

### 4. Reviews

A. Saw OFFICE CHRISTMAS PARTY, a not very funny comedy about a company that holds an epic office party in an attempt to impress a potential client. I usually like Jason Bateman and Jennifer Aniston in almost anything they are in, but neither could save this film. And Rob Cordery is wasted in a role that doesn't give him much of an opportunity to display his talents. Rated R.

B. BRIDGET JONES'S BABY is now out on DVD ... my review from BLAINESWORLD #1043 follows:  
Saw BRIDGET JONES'S BABY, the third film in the comedy series about a single woman played by Renée Zellweger who becomes unexpectedly pregnant. The only problem: She's not sure if Colin Firth or Patrick Dempsey is the father. The film dragged for me, though it did manage to come alive in the last 15 minutes. A large part of my problem was the fact that I had already seen most of the best scenes too many times via trailers before other films. Rated R, though methinks it would be appropriate for any mature teenager.

C. Read the e-book version of I STOOGED TO CONQUER: THE AUTOBIOGRAPHY OF THE LEADER OF THE THREE STOOGES (Chicago Review Press) by Moe Howard. ... I was a big fan of the Three Stooges when growing up, but knew little about them until I read this account by the brain behind the group's success. ... It felt like the author was sitting next to me, telling stories of both his vaudeville and TV days. I especially liked his account of how he had to rebuild the Stooges on three separate occasions due to untimely deaths. ... The many pictures were an added bonus.

D. Heard LAST GIRL BEFORE FREEWAY: THE LIFE, LOVES, LOSSES, AND LIBERATION OF JOAN RIVERS (Hachette Audio), written by Leslie Bennetts and read by Erin Bennett. ... Rivers was a comedian, actress, writer, producer and television host noted for her acerbic wit that could both offend and delight. This book helped me better understand the inner workings of the trailblazer whose mother was so desperate to marry her off that she posted a sign with the book's title in their yard advertising Rivers' availability—or so Joan joked early in her career. ... I liked the tributes at the end from those who were influenced by Joan Rivers, including this one from Sarah Silverman: [She was] "the poster girl for perseverance" whose "existence changed everything for women in comedy." ... The only thing needed in this book were photographs from her career. I assume there were some in the hard cover book, and they would have added to my enjoyment of this version.

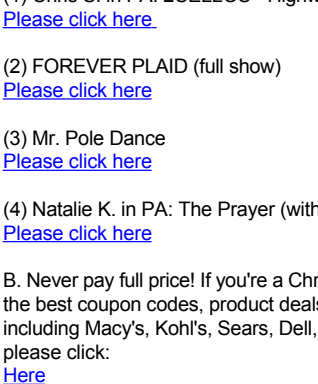

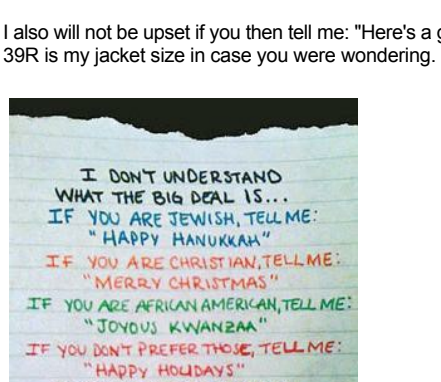

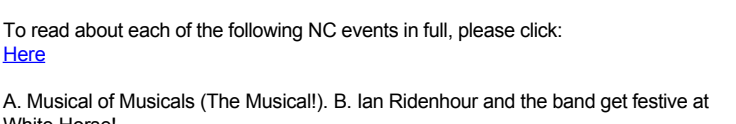
