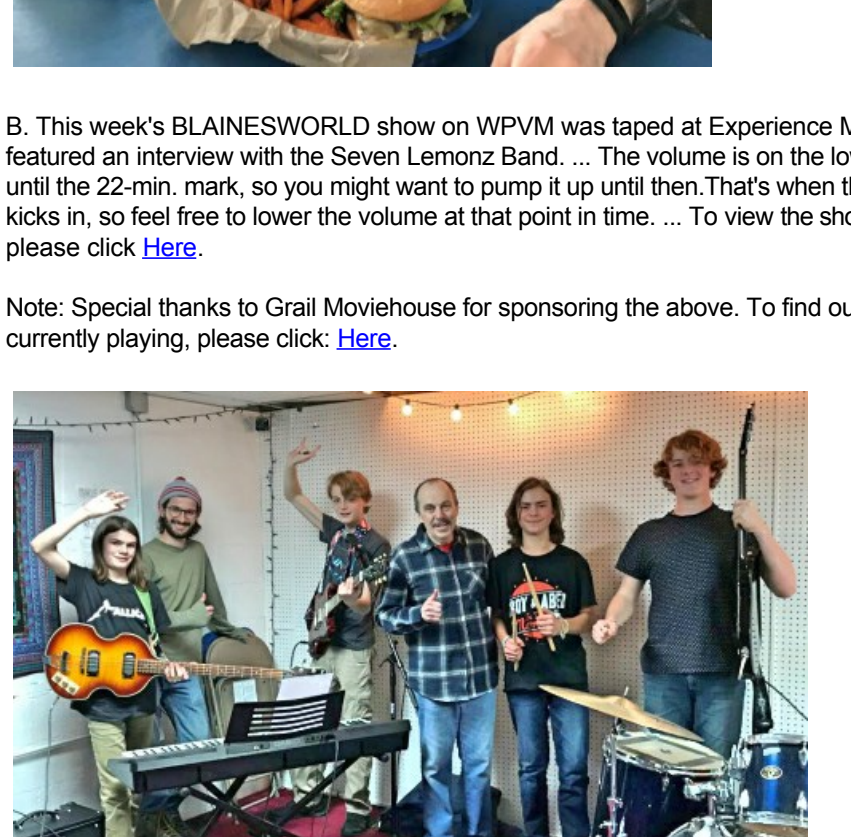
A. Cynthia, my beautiful bride, and I:

- (1) Had the pleasure of hosting our friends Annemarie Brown and Marvin Sadovsky for dinner, followed by a couple of fierce games of Spot it!

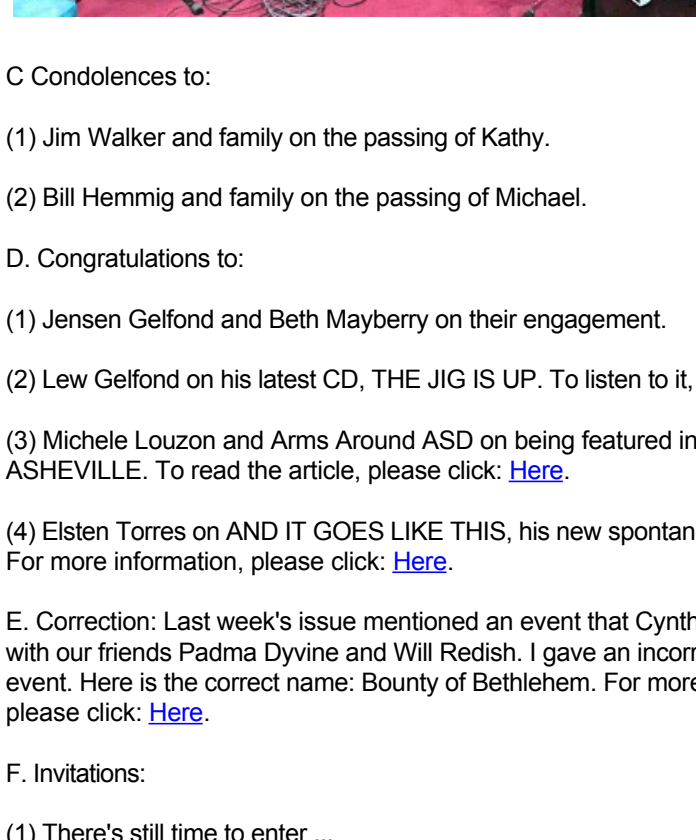

- (2) We also got together with our friend Ellane Chandler for a tasty dinner at Twisted Crepe.

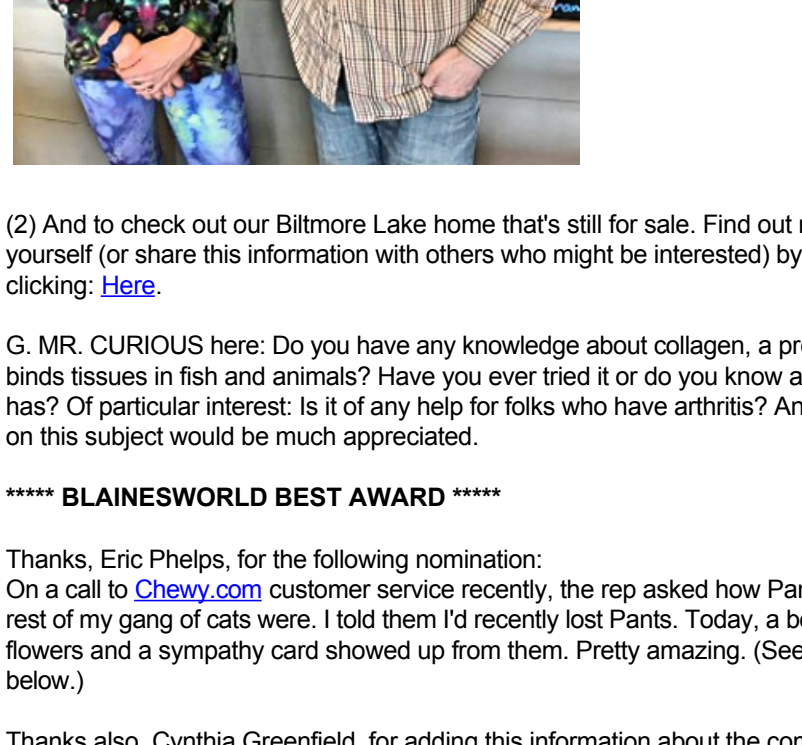


- (3) And we checked out Blue Sky Cafe in Fletcher for the first time. The food is good, the portions are generous and the prices are reasonable. We'll be back.

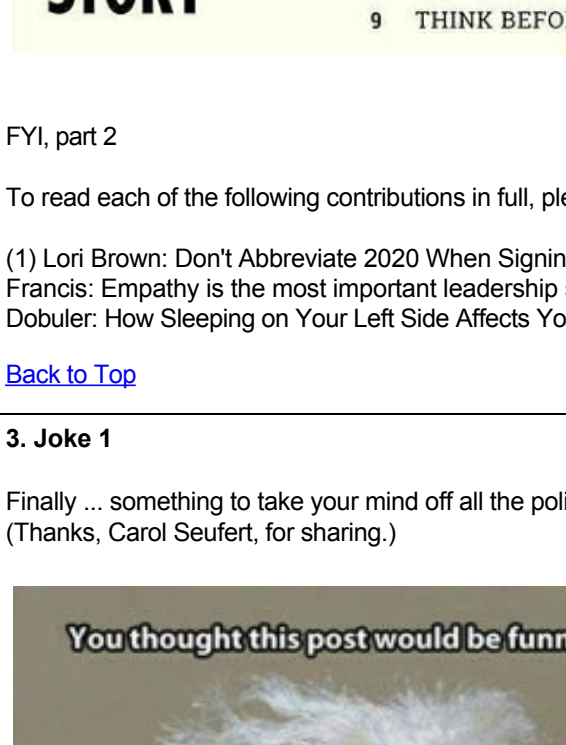

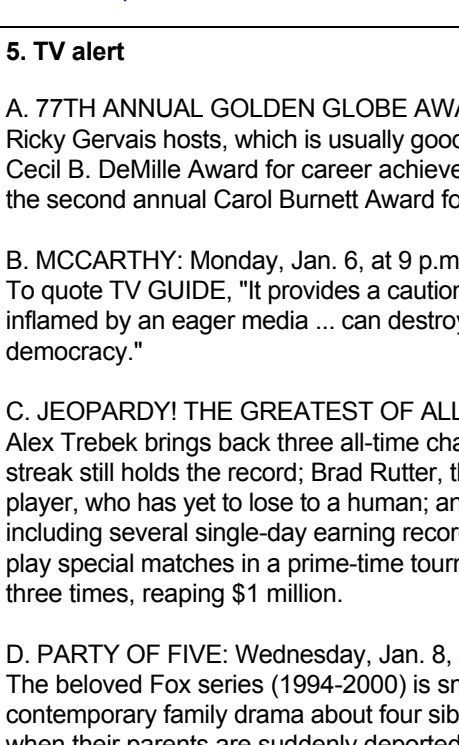
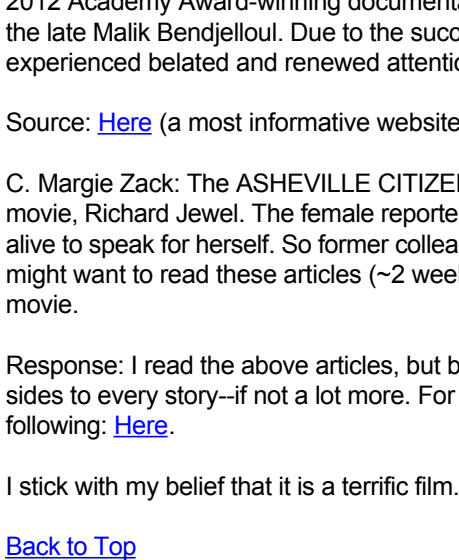

**4. Reviews**

A. Saw BOMBSHELL, an engaging drama based on the sexual harassment scandal at Fox News. Charlize Theron, Nicole Kidman and Margot Robbie and John Lithgow are all excellent in their respective roles. Special credit and a likely Oscar nomination (and probable win) goes to makeup designer Kaxu Hiro. His work is amazing. Rated R.

Note: Find SEARCHING FOR SUGAR MAN on Netflix and see if it you want to learn more about the greatest 70s icon who never was. The documentary is the incredible true story of Rodriguez, a singer who was discovered in a Detroit bar and who recorded one album that went nowhere. He soon faded into obscurity, but a bootleg recording found its way into apartheid South Africa and over the next two decades, Rodriguez became a phenomenon. This film about his life won a well-deserved Best Documentary Oscar in 2013. The story is amazing and so is the music. Rated PG-13.

I then read some more about his life. Here's a Reader's Digest version:  
It's one of pop music's unlikeliest and greatest comeback stories ever: a Mexican-American singer-songwriter from Detroit named Sixto Rodriguez recorded two albums of psychedelic folk rock in the early 1970s that went nowhere in the U.S. upon their initial release; afterwards, he worked in construction. Unbeknownst to him, his music was a huge hit in South Africa, where his unsentimental and gritty outsider lyrics resonated with young liberal Afrikaners during that country's policy of apartheid. Rodriguez's impact on South Africa and his subsequent reemergence in the late 1990s--thanks to the efforts of some dedicated fans--formed the crux of the 2012 Academy Award-winning documentary Searching for Sugar Man, directed by the late Malik Bendjelloul. Due to the success of the film, Rodriguez's music has experienced belated and renewed attention.
