- A. In heaven, there were two lines. One had a sign that read, "Men who were bossed by their wives," and

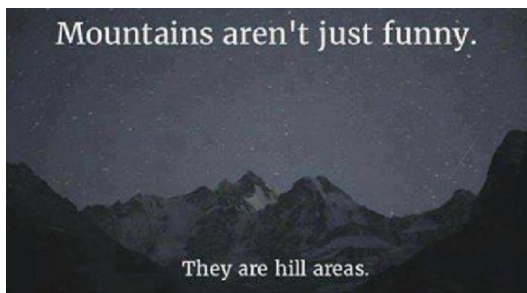
the other read, "Men who weren't bossed by their wives."

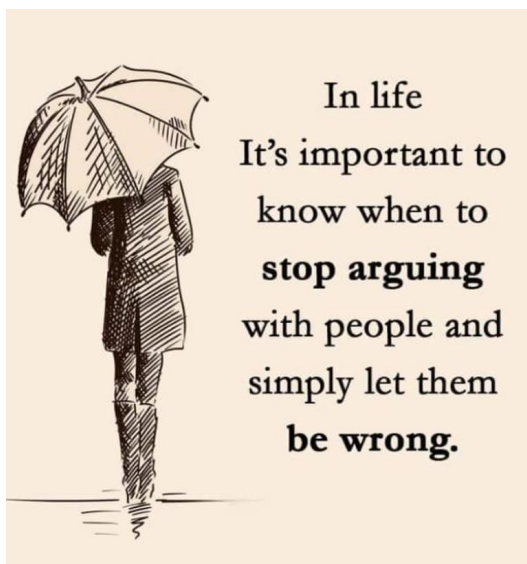
The man shrugged and replied, "My wife told me to stand here."

"Well OK," I finally agreed, "but my wife won't like it."

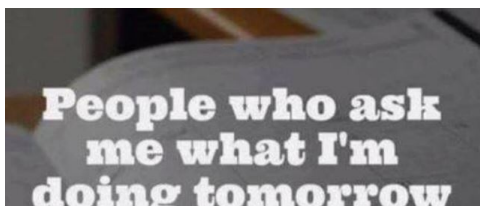
After a drink and an amazing back rub, I thanked my host. "I feel much better now, but my wife won't like it."
